**The year 2008 started with an intensity I'm not used to** when I learned that images of my *Prix de West Invitational* paintings would be needed much earlier than I'd anticipated. The National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum hosts this prestigious invitational art exhibit of paintings and sculpture by the finest contemporary artists in the nation. Sporting scenes, landscapes, and wildlife are always highlighted in the exhibition along with western themes. This annual exhibition begins with two days of seminars on art-related topics and art demonstrations. The weekend culminates with a fixed-price sale of all the exhibition pieces and an awards banquet.
